Privacy

The Bridge for Africa website operates in line with the provisions of South Africa's Protection of Personal Information (POPI) Act, No 4 of 2013.

The only personal information held on the restricted access, Pianola section of the Bridge for Africa website is the first and last name of bridge players, their club and their tournament results, though players can choose to add additional personal information. Each user can control how much personal information to share with other players. By default, all contact information is hidden from view to other players.

Each user chooses his or her own username and password. All passwords are stored using one-way encryption so it is impossible for anyone, even the website administrator, to read them.

The Pianola database is stored on a secure server located in a secure data centre run by Amazon. Look for the padlock in your browser that shows your personal data is being encrypted as it passes over the Internet. The data is backed up every hour.

We comply with anti-spam laws by always providing an unsubscribe link in E-mails, and never revealing recipients' email addresses publicly.

We will never share or sell your contact details.
